### Please read:

1. \*\*\* RMP members who have not renewed their membership for 2009 need to do so to receive the member discount.
2. Early arrivals will have to make arrangements directly through the State Park Central Reservations. RMP is not responsible for camping arrangements for Tuesday or Sunday nights.
3. **RV owners will need to contact Colorado State Parks Reservations** <http://coloradostateparks.reserveamerica.com/> or 303-470-1144 directly for reservations. **RV parking is not included in your reservation fees.** We are camping in Loop A which are electric only hookups. Loop C has full hookups available. Shower and Laundry facilities are available very near our camp sites. Showers are coin operated, \$1 buys 4 minutes. Bring quarters!
4. **Island Acres State Park campground does not have Cabin facilities available. Those who do not want to tent camp should make arrangements for offsite accommodations or rent an RV for onsite RV camping.**
5. There are limited spaces for extra vehicles and trailers in the campground. Additional vehicles may have to park off site.

6. Camping areas are all designated and will be assigned by the Treffen hosts on arrival.
7. Colorado State Parks will charge a \$6 per day/per vehicle park day pass. I suggest getting an annual State Park pass; they are good for all Colorado state parks for 1 full year, and are available for \$60 at <http://parks.state.co.us/parksstore/>. (Sorry, they wouldn't let the RMP cover this in the reservation fees)
8. There are no discounts for late arrivals or early departures (Thursday-Saturday).
9. All adult registrants must complete a release of liability at the registration tent before participating in any Treffen event.
10. This is a European Vintage Military Vehicle specific event. Please do not bring any other vehicles with the intent of participating in Treffen events.

### **Please read the following additional information:**

We welcome you to the 10th annual Treffen! We need your help to insure that all events and activities go as smoothly and safely as possible. For all information on locations, event schedules, and activities, go to our website at <http://www.rmpinzgauers.org> and click on the Treffen 09 link. When you are at the Treffen, come to the Treffen Central Tent to get the latest information.

To comfortably accommodate everyone attending, The Treffen hosts will help you to find a good camping site. Camping spaces at the park are designated. Some of the larger sites may need to accommodate 2 groups. Please help us to get everyone a good camping spot by following the Host's directions.

**\*\*All adult registrants will be required to read and sign an event waiver before they participate in any Treffen activities. No exceptions!\*\***

- Safety is always our #1 concern.
- Please observe the 5mph speed limit in the campground at all times. All park rules will be enforced.
- Please watch your children. We will be camping directly next to the Colorado River which runs very fast and deep. There are several ponds and a swimming hole nearby in the campground for those that need to cool off.
- Palisade can get very hot in the daytime, and very cold even in the summer, especially at night or during wet weather. Please bring adequate water, shade, and cold weather camping gear and outerwear.
- We will be traveling through a wide range of altitude and weather conditions on our trail rides. As many of you are aware, Colorado weather can change quickly throughout the day and afternoon thunderstorms are very common in the summer. Please plan on wet weather during the trail rides no matter how the day starts out.
- If you have medical problems that can be aggravated by the altitude, please try and moderate your exertion level. Drink plenty of water. Dehydration is a common cause of many illnesses at altitude.
- In case of illness or injury, please notify a Treffen Host as soon as possible.
- Firewood is available for sale at the park office at premium prices. If you want a campfire in the evening, it is much cheaper to bring your own wood. Foraging for wood in the park is not allowed.

**Trail rides:** We will be doing trails of varying difficulty though most are **moderate to difficult**. Please study the lists of available rides and choose ones suited to your driving comfort and your vehicle's ability. The Rocky Mountain Pinzgauers **are not responsible** for damage to your vehicle or injuries sustained during our trail rides. For those that do not want to participate in a particular days' trail ride, there are a host of other activities to do in the area. Please see <http://parks.state.co.us/Parks/JamesMRobbColoradoRiver/LocalAttractionsLinks/> for some suggestions. Glenwood Hot Springs is about 40 minutes away; there are several rafting companies that do full and ½ day raft trips on the Colorado; and the Palisade Wineries give daily tours and tastings.

**Communications:** If you don't have one, consider putting a CB radio in your truck or get a good quality CB portable. CB's are our primary way of communicating during trail rides & "convoy" style events and they will make your participation in the events more informative and enjoyable. We'll be using channel 4 for the entire event.

**Dogs: Due to consistent & serious problems with dogs at RMP events, Dogs are no longer allowed at any RMP sponsored event including Treffen.**

**Campground Quiet time** is 10 PM to 6 AM. Please be considerate of the other guests. This rule strictly enforced.
